



Competitor Notes

Rules

- All drivers must have a transponder and one way radio/scanners.
- Modified and Sportsman teams will follow DIRTcar technical rules for this event. Tech will be present. This includes Hoosier Tires (only the D300 / D400) and VP Racing fuels.
- **In coordination with DIRTcar Nationals Rules: The maximum height of the rear deck when measured from the ground will be 47"-inches and a minimum of 40"-inches. The maximum overall height with the spoiler when measured from the ground will also not exceed 47"-inches for Modifieds.**
- **TIRE SAMPLES WILL BE TAKEN DURING THE WEEK**
- Sportsman must maintain 6,000 RPM as per the DIRTcar rules.

Modified/Sportsman Heat Race Format

31 or less cars - 3 heats (6 qualify / 3 to redraw - 9 cars)
32 or more cars - 4 heats (5 qualify / 2 to redraw - 8 cars)
48 or more cars - 6 heats (3 qualify / 1 to redraw - 6 cars)

The number of consolations and qualifiers will be determined on car count on race night.

Modified/Sportsman Timed Warm-Ups Format

Drivers will draw for their heat-race groups. Heat-race groups will hot lap together and it will be timed. Drivers will get a green-white-checkered system. Drivers' best time counts toward their heat race starting position. In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker is the driver's second timed lap. Heat starting positions will be determined by an inversion of four cars in each heat.

IF YOU MISS YOUR ASSIGNED GROUP YOU WILL START AT THE REAR OF YOUR ASSIGNED HEAT RACE.

Modified / Sportsman Race Feature Format

- Cautions laps do not count
- Two courtesy laps to change a flat tire / make repairs from crash in the feature event prior to halfway ONLY. Drivers are only eligible for ONE time in the pit area. The driver must be on the lead lap.
- Any driver that stops on the speedway to bring out an intentional yellow without a flat tire will be penalized one lap and will not receive any courtesy laps.
- There will be one wave around driver that is one lap down per caution flag period unless there are back-to-back cautions on the same lap. Then only the first caution counts.
- At every caution, lapped cars will be placed back behind lead lap cars. The wave around car will fall in line behind the last car on the lead lap.
- Two cautions on the same lap the restart will be single file. All other restarts will be double file until the conclusion of the feature event.
- The race will finish under a green, white, checkered format. A race can be extended with a caution on the final lap.
